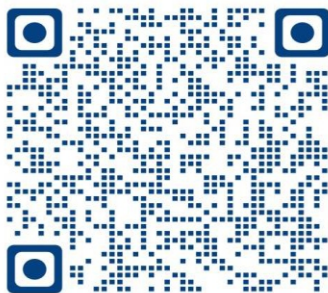
The CILT annual Conference is here again.
